We address the barriers that keep vulnerable children out of school, including poverty, gender norms, disability, early marriage, and unsafe learning environments.

WE WORK TO:

- Reduce dropout rates by at least 85% in the schools we support.
- Ensure access to education for 30,000 children and youth.
- Support 2,000 families to recognize and advocate for girls' right to education.
- Promote safeguarding and inclusive policies in schools.

WHAT WE DO

- **Inclusive access**
We provide scholarships and practical support to children from poor families, especially girls and children with disabilities.
- **Safe and supportive learning environments**
We invest in WASH (Water, Sanitation and Hygiene) infrastructure, school safety, and menstrual health management to ensure that schools are safer for all – especially girls.
- **Community engagement**
We mobilize parents, school boards, and local leaders to actively support education. Especially for parents to keep their daughters in school.
- **Youth leadership & participation**
Through youth-led clubs, life skills training, and advocacy, we empower young people to take ownership of their futures – also in school.
- **Critical thinking**
We use creative writing as a tool to develop critical thinking, self-expression, and active reflection among youth. By writing their own stories, poems, and reflections, young people explore social issues and personal values – enhancing both literacy and analytical skills while building confidence and voice.

We believe education must go beyond school access—it must also foster confidence, critical thinking, and a sense of belonging. Our work ensures that education prepares young people not only for jobs, but for leadership and active citizenship.
